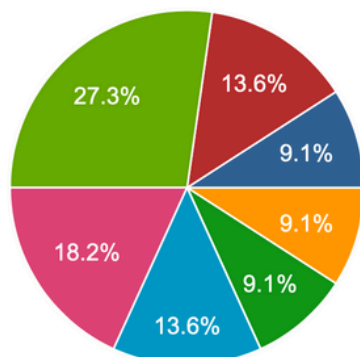

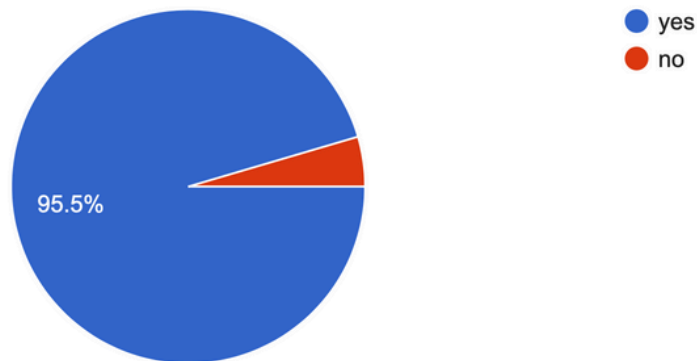

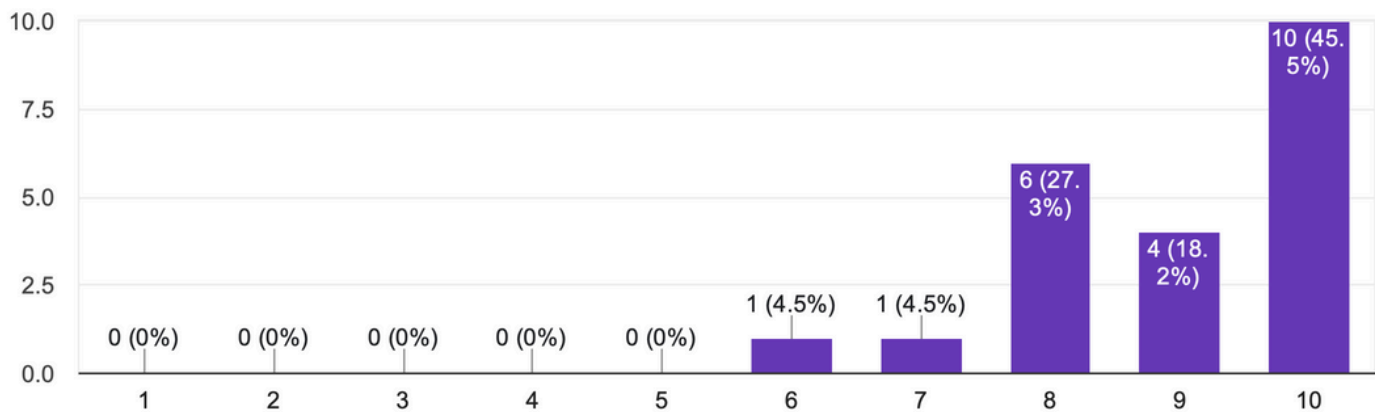
Did you learn about new culture and religion

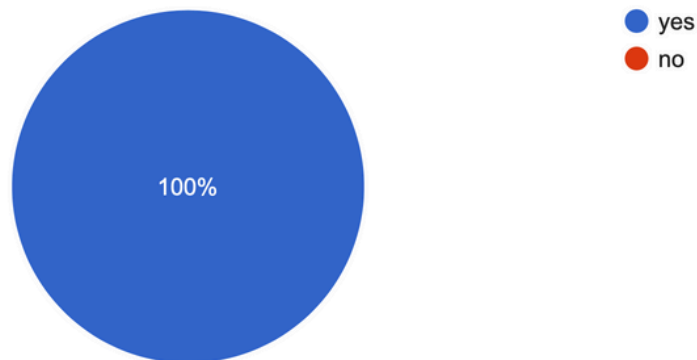

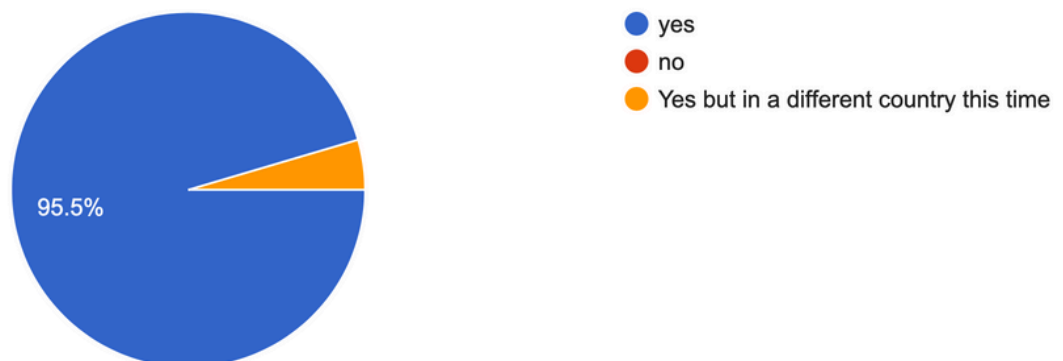
Do you think this mobility will help you to gain new skills?
